Call for Nominations of IAMM Awards and Prizes 2014

1. **Dr SC Agarwal Oration 2013;** This award is supported from the interest incurred from a fund donated by Dr SC Agarwal, to be given to a senior member of the association for his / her outstanding contribution to the field of Medical Microbiology. Nominations for the award, duly proposed and seconded with the consent of the nominee along with consent of the nominee along with six copies of his/her biodata should reach the IAMM secretaries office on or before June 30th 2014. The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The selected candidate must be prepared to deliver the oration at the National IAMM Conference held in next year. Nominations must come by post/courier as a hard copy by the last date. Nominations received by fax or email will not be accepted.
2. **Dr.H.I.Jhala Memorial award 2013;** This award is given to a senior member of the association above the age of 50 years, who has made significant contribution to the development of Medical microbiology in India. This award is supported from the interest from the fixed deposit donated by the organizers of the IAMM congress held at Sholapur in 1983. Nominations for the award, duly proposed and seconded with the consent of the nominee along with consent of the nominee along with six copies of his/her biodata should reach the IAMM secretaries office June 30th 2014.. The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The selected candidate must be prepared to deliver the oration at the National IAMM Conference held next year. Nominations must come by post/courier as a hard copy by the last date. Nominations received by fax or email will not be accepted.
3. **IAMM Endowment lecture award 2013;** This award is supported by the annual interest obtained from the fixed deposit, donated by the organizers of the IAMM congress held at Hyderabad in 1985. This award is given to an eminent Medical Microbiologist, over the age of 50 years from India and abroad for their outstanding work in the field of Medical Microbiology, Bacteriology, Virology, Mycology, Parasitology /Immunology/Epidemiology/ and Microbiological techniques. Nominations for the award, duly proposed and seconded with the consent of the nominee along with consent of the nominee along with six copies of his/her biodata, including a write upon the contribution of the nominee to Medical Microbiology should reach the IAMM secretaries office June 30th 2014. The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The selected candidate must be prepared to deliver the oration at the National IAMM Conference held in next year. Nominations must come by post/courier as a hard copy by the last date. Nominations received by fax or email will not be accepted.
4. **IAMM Junior Best Paper Award;** Nominations are invited for the Best paper award competition to be held at National Conference of the IAMM. This award is supported by the annual interest obtained from the fixed deposit, donated by the organizers of the IAMM congress held at Bombay in 1979. The contestant should be a member of IAMM, less than 35 years of age (certificate showing the proof of age should be attached) as on 31st July 2014 and be the principle author of the paper. The same paper should not have received any other award or be published in any other award or be published in any journal and should be so certified, as a signed declaration by the contestant. The aforementioned declarations and six copies of the full paper complete with tables, figures, etc.(prepared according to the format of the IJMM) should reach the secretary's office before July 31st 2014.The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The selected candidate will receive the citation and a gold medal at the valedictory function of the IAMM Conference. Nominations must come by post/courier as a hard copy by the last date. Nominations received by fax or email will not be accepted.
5. **Prof AN Chakrabarthy memorial Prize for the best published paper in Mycobacteriology 2013.** Any member, who has published a paper in the field of Mycobacteriology, during the preceding year i.e. 2013 in any National/International journal, will be eligible to submit paper for the award. The paper should not have received any other award and a declaration to that effect should be submitted while applying for the award. The aforementioned declarations and six copies of the full paper should reach the secretary's office before July 31st 2014. The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The awardee will receive the award at the valedictory function of the IAMM.
6. **Prizes for the best papers / posters during the IAMM Conference** (total six categories listed below) The following five prizes are given during the National Conference of the IAMM in Various categories:
 1. NAWOPIA Dr Pankajlaxmi V Venugopal Prize for the Best paper in Mycology.
 2. Dr SR Sengupta- Dr AM Saoji memorial prize for the best paper in Immunology.
 3. Dr SS Kelkar Memorial prize for the best poster (any subject in Medical Microbiology).
 4. IAMM silver Jubilee Prize for Best Paper in Parasitology.
 5. Mumbai-Belgaum Prize for the best poster in Medical Mycobacteriology.
 6. Belgaum-Mumbai Prize for the best paper in Bacteriology.

Nominations are invited for the above said prizes. Any IAMM member is eligible to contest for these awards. Abstracts for the award papers from interested members must be submitted to the IAMM Secretaries office on or before July 31st 2014. These will be subjected to peer review and only selected abstracts will be allowed to be presented as a paper at the respective oral/ poster sessions. The best paper amongst those will be adjudged the best paper by the panel of judges. The authors of an abstract must express their interest in a particular category while submitting the abstract. All the awards will be presented at the valedictory function.

Minutes of GB meeting held on November 2013 at NIMS Hyderabad

At the outset, Dr. Mahantesh B Nagamoti, Secretary of IAMM, welcomed all the members and Past Presidents of the association to the General Body Meeting at Novotel HICC Hyderabad on 23rd Nov 2013. He requested the President of IAMM Dr. Reba Kanungo to chair the meeting and conduct the proceedings.

The president called the meeting to order

- Minutes of the General Body Meeting held at Lady Hardinge Medical College 2012 was read and confirmed by the GB (proposed by Dr. V Ravi and seconded by Dr. A Chowdhary).
- IAMM Secretary report for 2013: Dr. M B Nagamoti presented the secretary's report and expenditure report for the year. It was accepted by the GB (proposed by Dr. Satish Patil and seconded by Dr. Arunaloke C)
- IJMM Editor's annual report and expenditure: Dr. Arti Kapil presented the report and announced the name of the award winners for the best published papers (IAMM 2012). Dr. Ravi congratulated the editorial team for improving the financial and publications standards. He suggested to present the full report and also to add photo quiz for betterment of the journal. He also requested the editor to contact other fellow editors for adopting measures towards further improvement of IJMM. Dr. Priya Abraham and Chand Wattal requested to publish IJMM supplements and special issues respectively. Editor welcomed and accepted these suggestions. (Proposed by Dr. S Sharma, seconded by Dr. Priya Abraham)
- IAMM Treasurer's report: Dr Deepak M, IAMM Treasurer made the Power point presentations of the audited report of the association for the year 2012. (proposed by Dr. V Ravi and seconded by Dr. A Chakraborty). Col. Nagendra enquired about the unaudited amount and the treasurer replied that he will present the same along with the updated report in the forth coming IAMM 2014 conference. Dr Arunaloke C congratulated him and suggested the GB that IAMM should have permanent office and permanent Assistant Treasurer in order to streamline the IAMM accounts. Many members supported this view and further added that the Treasurer's office should be located in a metro city. GB accepted the suggestion and proposed the name of Dr BS Sherwal was requested to shoulder this responsibility. Dr. Sherwal accepted the responsibility and said that he will start the office on rental basis and then look for a permanent office around Delhi. Dr. Deepak M, suggested the GB that around 25 lakhs can be used for the office construction from the treasurer's office. Dr Sherwal proposed the name of his colleague Dr. Sonal Saxena (Delhi) for the Asst Treasurer post. The GB approved the same (proposed by Dr. Savitri Sharma seconded by Dr. Arunaloke C).
- EQAS report: Dr. Mary Jesudasan read the EQAS report and informed the GB that around 800 labs are participating in IAMM EQAS. The GB congratulated Dr. Chand Wattal for establishing EQAS centre at New Delhi, which will cover North and North-Eastern states of India.

Dr. Chand Wattal thanked the GB and promised to start EQAS centre at New Delhi from Jan 2014 onwards. EQAS committee proposed to increase the subscription from Rs. 2000 to Rs. 2500. The GB approved the same (proposed by Col. Nagendra and seconded by Dr. V Ravi). Members requested to add a Feedback Form along with questionnaire to all the centers. Dr. Rama Chowdhary proposed to include EQAS for anaerobic bacteria. She said that she will initiate this in collaboration with Dr Chand Wattal. President assured her to consider the issue.

Dr. Chand Wattal thanked the GB and promised to start EQAS centre at New Delhi from Jan 2014 onwards. EQAS committee proposed to increase the subscription from Rs. 2000 to Rs. 2500. The GB approved the same (proposed by Col. Nagendra and seconded by Dr. V Ravi). Members requested to add a Feedback Form along with questionnaire to all the centers. Dr. Rama Chowdhary proposed to include EQAS for anaerobic bacteria. She said that she will initiate this in collaboration with Dr Chand Wattal. President assured her to consider the issue.

- IAMM Symposium: Secretary read out the various topics proposed by the members and they were analysed in length and finally the topic "Role of Microbiologist in public health" was approved and the Moderator for this was Dr. Chand Wattal.

- Outsourcing conference: Dr. Abhay C suggested to accept grant of funds from the corporate companies for hosting the conference like other national associations' conferences. He also suggested to formulate the strategy for the management of funds. President Dr. Reba Kanungo informed the GB that as this issue was discussed in detail and was approved by EC members and she requested GB to analyse the same before consideration. Dr Arunaloke C opined to invite for bidding of the conference while the President formed a committee consisting of Dr. V Ravi, Dr. Abhay Chowdhary, Dr. B. L Sherwal, Dr. Arunaloke C along with Secretary to work on it.

This was approved by GB (proposed by Dr. Anuj Kagal and seconded by Dr. B L Sherwal).

- Student symposium: Secretary described about his difficulty to get the topic for IAMM student symposium 2013, even after announcing it in the news letter. Considering this, GB proposed the Dr. Vijay Kumar of Mysore as a coordinator for IAMM student symposium-2014. He has readily accepted the responsibility.

- Selection of Venue for the IAMM conference 2014 and 2015: G B approved the request of Dr. Bharati Malhotra of SMS Medical College Jaipur regarding hosting 2014 conference. Dr. Reba Kanungo, President IAMM has handover the letter of approval to Dr. Bharati Malhotra.

Dr. Harish of JIPMER Puduchery explained that JIPMER is celebrating golden jubilee year in 2015. In view of this, he requested the GB for hosting 2015 IAMM conference at JIPMER Puducherry. GB approved the same and asked him to submit the letter through Dean JIPMER to the Secretary IAMM.

- Election of office bearers: Dr. M B Nagamoti informed the house that Dr. Vijay Kumar of Mysore (EC Member) and Dr. D K Mendiratta (Treasurer) completed their tenures. The GB appreciated their role as office bearers of IAMM for 3 Years and thanked them for their valuable inputs. The

12. Other matters

- a. Dr. K B Sharma award: EC has approved the donation from Dr. K B Sharma Family towards Junior Best paper award and suggested this award to be named after “(Late) Dr K B Sharma Memorial IAMM Jr. Best paper award”. Dr. Sherwal has contacted the family members after the EC meeting and they have agreed for the proposal and will donate Rs. 2.5 lacs for the same. (Proposed by Dr. C S Patil and seconded by Dr. D S Agarwal)

- b. Secretary has received a request letter from Dr. Pronabeshwar Chakraborty, regarding award for the best published paper on the subject of Enterobacteriaceae. The EC and GB did not approve the request. Instead, GB felt that the travel grant for short/long term in India and abroad can be given to the young scientist for (1month/3month) training in reputed labs. Accepted by GB. (Proposed by Dr. R D Kulkarnii and Seconded by Dr. Savitri Sharma)
- c. Curriculum design/development: President Dr. Reba informed the members that she will conduct the expert committee meeting regarding the curriculum design for UG/PG students. Dr. C S Patil raised the doubt regarding acceptance of IAMM suggestions by MCI. Dr. B L Sherwal explained about present instable status of MCI.
- d. Website Maintenance: President informed to GB that, Dr. V Balaji of CMC Vellore and Joint Secretary have been approved as the In charge officers for IAMM website maintenance for two years by EC. This responsibility was accepted and GB approved the same.

MICROCON 2013: XXXVII NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF INDIAN ASSOCIATION OF MEDICAL MICROBIOLOGISTS – EVENT REPORT

MICROCON-2013, the premier Annual National Conference of Medical Microbiologists was organized by the Department of Microbiology, Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences (NIMS), at Novotel, HICC, Hyderabad from 20th November to 24th November 2013. Dr. V Lakshmi, Professor and Head of Microbiology was the Organizing Secretary.

His Excellency, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh, Mr. ESL Narasimhan, formally inaugurated the event on 21st November 2013. Dr. VM Katoch, the Director General of ICMR, was the Guest of Honor.

The theme of MICROCON 2013 was “Clinical & Applied Microbiology – Future Trends” to emphasize the need to bridge education, research and practice to through collaboration to ensure effective control of infectious disease prevention and growth across the globe.

As pre-conference events, a CME on “Case studies in Infectious diseases” at NIMS and a total of nine workshops were held at various hospitals in the city. Sessions and topics included, advances in HIV diagnosis, full Microbiology lab automation, active learning strategies for microbiology, Molecular Microbiology, infection control, scientific writing, making of a microbiologist, CSSD and Ocular Microbiology.

The conference was a successful one with a large participation of over 1150 delegates. The conference program included three orations, parallel award sessions, two symposia, a mini workshop by the American Society of Microbiologists (ASM), one plenary Session by Dr. Madhukar Pai on TB and 30 scientific lectures by eminent and experienced scientists and clinicians (International Speakers - 11 and National - 19), 506 paper presentations (32 oral and 474 poster) by young Microbiologists and 26 instrument/manufacturers exhibits.

The Student symposium was on education and latest research in Medical Microbiology. The symposium on public health response to epidemics and emerging infections by eminent scientists was well received. Awards for the best papers during the conference were given away by Dr. Reba, President – IAMM 2012-13.
