Call for Nominations of IAMM Awards and Prizes 2015

- 1. Dr S.C. Agarwal Oration 2014: This award is supported from the interest incurred from a fund donated by Dr SC Agarwal, to be given to a senior member of the association for his / her outstanding contribution to the field of Medical Microbiology. Nominations for the award, duly proposed and seconded with the consent of the nominee along with consent of the nominee along with six copies of his/her biodata should reach the IAMM secretary's office on or before June 30th 2015. The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The selected candidate must be prepared to deliver the oration at the National IAMM Conference held in next year. Nominations must come by post/courier as a hard copy by the last date. Nominations received by fax or email will not be accepted.
- 2. **Dr. H. I. Jhala Memorial award 2014:** This award is given to a senior member of the association above the age of 50 years, who has made significant contribution to the development of Medical microbiology in India. This award is supported from the interest from the fixed deposit donated by the organizers of the IAMM congress held at Sholapur in 1983. Nominations for the award, duly proposed and seconded with the consent of the nominee along with consent of the nominee along with six copies of his/her biodata should reach the IAMM secretaries office June 30th 2015. The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The selected candidate must be prepared to deliver the oration at the National IAMM Conference held next year. Nominations must come by post/courier as a hard copy by the last date. Nominations received by fax or email will not be accepted.
- 3. IAMM Endowment lecture award 2014: This award is supported by the annual interest obtained from the fixed deposit, donated by the organizers of the IAMM congress held at Hyderabad in 1985. This award is given to an eminent Medical Microbiologist, over the age of 50 years from India and abroad for their outstanding work in the field of Medical Microbiology, Bacteriology, Virology, Mycology, Parasitology /Immunology/Epidemiology/ and Microbiological techniques. Nominations for the award, duly proposed and seconded with the consent of the nominee along with consent of the nominee along with six copies of his/her biodata, including a write upon the contribution of the nominee to Medical Microbiology should reach the IAMM secretaries office June 30th 2015. The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The selected candidate must be prepared to deliver the oration at the National IAMM Conference held in next year. Nominations must come by post/courier as a hard copy by the last date. Nominations received by fax or email will not be accepted.
- 4. Dr K.B. Sharma Memorial IAMM Junior Best Paper Award 2015: Nominations are invited for the Best paper award competition to be held at National Conference of the IAMM. This award is supported by the annual interest obtained from the fixed deposit, donated by the organizers of the IAMM congress held at Bombay in 1979 and Donations paid by (Late) Dr KB Sharma family members. The

- contestant should be a member of IAMM, less than 35 years of age (certificate showing the proof of age should be attached) as on 31st July 2015 and be the principle author of the paper. The same paper should not have received any other award or be published in any other award or be published in any journal and should be so certified, as a signed declaration by the contestant. The aforementioned declarations and six copies of the full paper complete with tables, figures, etc.(prepared according to the format of the IJMM) should reach the secretary's office before July 31st 2015. The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The selected candidate will receive the citation and a gold medal at the valedictory function of the IAMM Conference. Nominations must come by post/courier as a hard copy by the last date. Nominations received by fax or email will not be accepted.
- 5. Prof. A. N. Chakrabarthy Memorial Prize for the best published paper in Mycobacteriology 2014: Any member, who has published a paper in the field of Mycobacteriology, during the preceding year i.e. 2014 in any National/International journal, will be eligible to submit paper for the award. The paper should not have received any other award and a declaration to that effect should be submitted while applying for the award. The aforementioned declarations and six copies of the full paper should reach the secretary's office before July 31st 2015. The award carries a citation and a gold medal. The awardee will receive the award at the valedictory function of the IAMM.
- 6. Prizes for the best papers / posters during the IAMM 2015 Conference (total six categories listed below) The following five prizes are given during the National Conference of the IAMM in Various categories:
 - a. NAWOPIA Dr Pankajlaxmi V Venugopal Prize for the Best paper in Mycology.
 - b. Dr SR Sengupta- Dr AM Saoji memorial prize for the best paper in Immunology.
 - c. Dr SS Kelkar Memorial prize for the best poster (any subject in Medical Microbiology).
 - d. IAMM silver Jubilee Prize for Best Paper in Parasitology.
 - e. Mumbai-Belgaum Prize for the best poster in Medical Mycobacteriology.
 - f. Belgaum-Mumbai Prize for the best paper in Bacteriology.

Nominations are invited for the above said prizes. Any IAMM member is eligible to contest for these awards. Abstracts for the award papers from interested members must be submitted to the IAMM Secretaries office on or before July 31st 2015. These will be subjected to peer review and only selected abstracts will be allowed to be presented as a paper at the respective oral/ poster sessions. The best paper amongst those will be adjudged the best paper by the panel of judges. The authors of an abstract must express their interest in a particular category while submitting the abstract. All the awards will be presented at the valedictory function.

NEWS LETTER JANUARY - 2015

Minutes of GB meeting held on 18th October 2014 at SMS Jaipur

At the outset, Dr. Mahantesh B Nagamoti, Secretary of IAMM, requested the President of IAMM Dr. Pratibha Narang to chair the meeting and conduct the proceedings.

The president called the meeting to order

- Minutes of the General Body Meeting held at NIMS Hyderbad 2013 was read and confirmed by the GB (Proposed by Dr. V Ravi and Seconded by Dr Nagendra Vice Presidents).
- 2. IAMM Secretary report for 2013: Dr. M B Nagamoti presented the secretary's report and expenditure report for the year. It was accepted by the GB (proposed by Dr. Satish Patil and seconded by Dr. Arunaloke C)
- 3. IJMM Editor's annual report and expenditure: Dr. Arti Kapil presented the report and announced the name of the award winners for the best published papers (IAMM 2013) She also informed the house that impact factor level increased to 1.034. Members suggested to Obitutory news in IJMM, 2. To Start Special Supplements or 3. Increase the number of pages or issues. However Dr Arunloke C, suggested obitutory information is circulated to members through IAMM Newsletters and not include it in IJMM Journal. Dr. Ravi congratulated the editorial team and suggested to start the Special supplements on antimicrobials, virology etc. Editor welcomed and accepted these suggestions from members. She also informed the house that the increased rejection rate is due to major mistakes of article writing by the authors and the reasons for rejection has been informed to the authors. Dr Nagendra agreed about the Editors explanation regarding the contents of articles by members and editorial board follows normal procedure. (Proposed by A Chakrabarty, seconded by Dr. Nagendra). The GB also agreed the request for one more Asso Editor to IJMM and Suggested Dr Aparna Lahiri's name for the same. Dr Aparna Lahiri also agreed to serve the IAMM as Asso Editor IJMM.
- 4. IAMM Treasurer's report: Dr Deepak M, IAMM Ex-Treasurer made the Power point presentations of the audited report of the association for the year 2013. (Proposed by Dr. Satish patil and seconded by Dr. CS Patil). Members asked for the IAMM Directory (Hard copy) of his tenure, Dr Deepak M informed members that, he has released the same in the form of CD, it is on the IAMM website and has mailed to all the members. Dr Shanmugam informed the members that, deleted names of the founder members in the web site. He has requested the treasurer to maintain every members (founder/life) name and to mention person diseased, in case of he/she expired. House accepted the suggestions and Treasurer also agreed to do the same in the website. Dr Anju Kagal presented the expenditure report during the term of April to Sept 2014. She informed she wants to invest the amount in National bank in single account at Pune, but members suggested that IAMM account maintenance and IT returns can be submitted from any place in India and let the FD should be

- mature wherever they are there (at Dharwad) and later can be transferred to original account. Dr Nagendra and Dr Renu Bharadwaj suggested Life membership fee for NRI members to be increased to 500 US \$. Members accepted the suggestions and circulate same in the IJMM and in Website. Some mebers also requested to add the year of Life membership in the directory and Treasurer agreed to do it.(Proposed by Dr Renu Bharadwaj and seconded by Dr Mangala Ghatole)
- 5. EQAS report; In charges of both centres (i.e. chennai and New Delhi) have presented their activities (Dr Liily T and Dr C Wattal). There was a discussion regarding serological testing (EQAS South) and results by the EC/GB members. All the members suggested to withdraw the test assessment of EQAS on ASO test. Dr Reba K has reminded about proficiency testing membership, by these centres, which was proposed during last year at Hyderabad. Dr Lilly Theresse has informed that they haven't obtained EQAS with any of the international centre like UK / US. Dr Balaii has informed that CMC Vellore has registered for the UK EQAS. Due to the heavy fee to external Proficiency testing centres, President Dr Pratibha Narang has suggested to stepwise register EQAS with UK/US centres, like initially with Serology, later Bacteriology etc. Dr Wattal requested IAMM to fund this program. Treasurer suggested IAMM can support this with separate revolving fund to sponsor this membership. All the members unanimously agreed and President suggested this matter can be discussed in GB and it was approved by GB. EC also permitted Dr Wattal to purchase the instrument with EQAS funding for New Delhi centre with the suggestions from GB. GB also recommended to purchase the instrument in the name of EQAS. All the members unanimously suggested that all the activities including EQAS should be performed under the IAMM and not under particular individual / institute. All the transactions also should be performed under IAMM account. The GB permitted to reconstitute the EQAS committee and one of the members will visit and solve the problems of the EQAS centre. The members of this committee are Dr V Ravi, Dr Badrinath, Dr Arunloke C, Dr Deepak M and Dr MB Nagamoti. IAMM will sponsor the funding of this members visit to the centres. The GB also approved the addition of new faculty to Chennai centre Dr Malathi J. EC and GB suggested the IAMM website incharges to update the IAMM website with EQAS websites information (New Delhi and Chennai).
- Decision on Various awards; Dr MB Nagamoti read out the names of the IAMM award winners for the year 2014-15;
 a.Dr. S.C. Agarwal Prize – Dr Arti Malhotra. b.IAMM Endowment award – Dr Rama Chowdhary c. Dr. U. C. Chaturwedi Award – Dr. CS Patil. d. Dr. H.I. Jhala award – Not recommended.
- 7. Student symposium: EC approved Dr Shivaprakash PGI Chandigarh as a coordinator for IAMM Student symposium-2015. He has readily accepted the

responsibility.

- 8. IAMM Symposium: Secretary read out the various topics proposed by the members; a. Preparedness for the out Break. b. TB diagnosis from resource setting to state of the art the art lab. c. Debate on Conventional Vs Modern techniques. d. Newer Vaccines. The GB approved the topic "Update on Vaccines" for IAMM symposium and Dr Abhay Chowdhary as the Moderator.
- 9. Venue for the IAMM conference 2014 and 2015: G B approved the request of Dr. BN Harish Professor and Head Microbiology JIPMER Puducherry regarding hosting 2015 conference. Dr. Pratibha Narang, President IAMM has handed over the letter of approval to Dr. Harish BN. Dr Arunloke requested to permit to hoist IAMM 2016 conference at PGI Chandigarh. GB approved the same and asked him to submit the letter through Dean to the Secretary IAMM.
- 10. Election of office bearers: Dr. M B Nagamoti informed the house that Dr. MR Shivaprakash and Dr. Chiranjoy M have completed their tenures as EC Members. The GB appreciated their role as office bearers of IAMM for 3 Years and thanked them for their valuable inputs. Secretary also informed the house that Joint Secretary's post is also vacant as Dr Aprana Lahiri shifted to the post of Asso Editor IJMM. The GB approved the name of Dr BL Sherwal for Jt Secretary. Dr BL Sherwal also agrred to serve the Association as Joint Secretary. The GB approved the election of the following office bearers for the year 2014-15 President J Shanmugam.
- 11. Other matters
- Secretary has read the letter and request from Dr. Pronabeshwar Chakraborty, regarding award for the best published paper on the subject of Enterobacteriaceae. The

- EC and GB did not approve the request. Instead, GB felt that the travel grant for short term in India can be given to the young scientist for (one to three months) training in reputed labs in the same name. GB also suggested to collect Rs 10 lakh donation for the same. Dr Aparna Lahiri requested to the GB to inform the same to Dr Dr. Pronabeshwar Chakraborty. Dr Arunloke suggested to the secretary to write a letter and Dr Aparna Lahiri will inform him by phone. Accepted by GB. (Proposed by Dr. Arunloke C and Seconded by Dr. CS Patil)
- b. Members requested to add obitutory in IJMM, but members felt that this information has already circulated through IAMM Newsletters and will continue the same.
- c. Website Maintenance: President informed to GB that, Dr. V Balaji of CMC Vellore, Joint Secretary Dr BL Sherwal and Dr Satish Patil (Karad) have been approved as the Incharge officers for IAMM website maintenance. This responsibility was accepted and GB approved the same.
- d. Dr MB Nagamoti Secretary IAMM has informed the members regarding ASM collaboration on Travel, Awards, Workshop and Journal along with Curriculum development. The GB requested the President to screen the applications from student who are eligible for the travel grant and Suggest the ASM members to sponsor the students. GB also suggested the President to circulate the MOU to all the members before it is signed. President suggested Secretary to circulate the MOU through News Letter.
- e. Secretary read the letter from Vidarbha Association (Maharastra) to consider itself as a separate chapter. The GB has not approved the request and suggested to continue as a part of IAMM Maharashtra IAMM chapter.

Summary of 38th Microcon - 2014 at Jaipur

MICROCON-2014, 38th Annual National Conference of Indian association of Medical Microbiologists was organized by the Department of Microbiology & Immunology, Sawai Man Singh (SMS) Medical College at B.M. Birla Auditorium Jaipur (Rajasthan) from 15th to 19th October 2014. Dr. Bharti Malhotra, Sr. Professor of Microbiology & Immunology was the Organizing Secretary and Dr Rakesh Maheshwari Organising Chairperson. Honorable Health Minister Dr. Rajender Singh Rathor formally inaugurated the event on 16th October 2014. Dr.VM Katoch, Secretary, Department of Health Research & Director General of ICMR, was the Guest of Honor. Dr Pratibha Narang President IAMM precided over the function. The theme of MICROCON 2014 was "Syndromic & Integrative Approach – The Way Ahead".

The conference was very successful with a large participation of 1340 delegates. As pre-conference events, a CME on "Syndromic Approach to Common

Infections" was held at Birla Auditorium, There were 12 pre conference workshops held at SMS Medical College, BM Birla Science Centre, Fortis Hospital and STDC, Ajmer. Scientific program included 2 orations, 33 with 75 scientific lectures. ASM panel discussion on safe secure and sustainable lab design was very well received in the current scenario of emerging Ebola virus infection and MDRTB & XDRTB. The Student symposium on "Epidemiology of Exanthematous viral disease –India geographical distribution, transmission, vector, reservoir, number of outbreak, mortality/ morbidity" was well received. IAMM symposium on role of medical microbiologists in public health stimulated deep discussions.716 abstracts were received and 686 paper accepted for presentations (164 oral and 522 poster) by young Microbiologists, parallel award sessions were also held.

Dr. Pratibha Narang, President – IAMM, Dr P Kumar Director NTI attended the valedictory function.
